Fenestration Installation



This course is aimed at those who work as installers of glass supporting systems, which include window and door units. The standards cover the most important aspects of the job. This qualification is at Level 2, although there may be individual units at other levels, and should be taken by those who are fully trained to deal with routine assignments. Candidates should require minimum supervision in undertaking the job.

Candidates for this qualification will primarily be working on customers premises installing windows and doors.

Who is this suitable for?

This qualification is ideal for those working in the construction industry and specialising in glazing installation.



Course Contents

- » Induction to the program

Awarding Body

This qualification allows the operative to gain their NVQ Level 2 certificate which will enable them to apply for and obtain their blue skilled workers card (CSCS card) – either online or by post.

Length of Course

This course can be completed within 5 months and contains assessment carried out in the workplace.
